AN ACT

Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to insurance; establishing an insurance department; and amending, revising, and 3 consolidating the law relating to the licensing, 4 qualification, regulation, examination, suspension, and dissolution of insurance companies, Lloyds associations, 5 reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and certain 7 societies and orders, the examination and regulation of fire 8 insurance rating bureaus, and the licensing and regulation of 9 insurance agents and brokers; the service of legal process 10 upon foreign insurance companies, associations or exchanges; 11 providing penalties, and repealing existing laws," providing 12 13 for life insurance database. 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), known as The Insurance Department Act of 1921, is amended by adding a 18 section to read: 19 Section 207A. Life Insurance Database. -- (a) The Insurance 20 Department shall maintain an electronic database of contact 21 information for each life insurer that has life insurance

policies in force in this Commonwealth.

- 1 (b) Beginning on January 1, 2015, any member of the
- 2 immediate family FAMILY WHO HAS REQUESTED AND OBTAINED A COPY OF <--
- 3 THE DECEDENT'S DEATH CERTIFICATE, executor or administrator of a
- 4 <u>decedent who is searching for life insurance policies covering</u>
- 5 the decedent may file a request with the department for a search
- 6 pursuant to this section, provided the decedent was a resident
- 7 or former resident of this Commonwealth. The request shall
- 8 include a copy of the decedent's death certificate. The right to
- 9 file a request for a search pursuant to this section may not be
- 10 assigned.
- 11 (c) The department shall transmit a search request to all
- 12 <u>life insurers having life insurance policies in force in this</u>
- 13 Commonwealth, along with information necessary for responding
- 14 directly to the person filing the request. Each insurer shall
- 15 examine its books and records to determine whether the decedent
- 16 is covered by a life insurance policy, and upon a finding that
- 17 coverage does exist, the insurer shall directly notify the
- 18 person filing the request.
- 19 (d) Insurers of credit life insurance, as defined in section
- 20 <u>2 of the act of September 2, 1961 (P.L.1232, No.540), known as</u>
- 21 the "Model Act for the Regulation of Credit Life Insurance and
- 22 <u>Credit Accident and Health Insurance," are exempt from the</u>
- 23 provisions of this act.
- 24 (e) The department may charge ten dollars (\$10) for each
- 25 search request processed through the database. Beginning one
- 26 year after the effective date of this section the department
- 27 <u>shall have authority to increase the fee charged. The fee</u>
- 28 increase shall not:
- 29 (1) exceed an annual cost-of-living adjustment as calculated
- 30 by applying the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index

- 1 for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New
- 2 <u>Jersey</u>, <u>Delaware and Maryland area for the most recent 12-month</u>
- 3 period for which figures have been officially reported by the
- 4 <u>United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics;</u>
- 5 <u>and</u>
- 6 (2) exceed twenty per centum (20%) annually.
- 7 (f) The department may adopt rules and regulations to
- 8 <u>implement the provisions of this section.</u>
- 9 (q) For purposes of this section, the term "immediate <--
- 10 <u>family" means a parent, spouse, child, brother or sister.</u>
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015.
