AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 22, 2005 (P.L.474, No.94), entitled
2 "An act providing for the notification of residents whose
3 personal information data was or may have been disclosed due
4 to a security system breach; and imposing penalties," further
5 providing for definitions.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The definition of "personal information" in
9 section 2 of the act of December 22, 2005 (P.L.474, No.94),
10 known as the Breach of Personal Information Notification Act,
11 amended November 3, 2022 (P.L.2139, No.151), is amended and the
12 section is amended by adding a definition to read:

13 Section 2. Definitions.

14 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
15 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
16 context clearly indicates otherwise:

18 "Digital wallet." An electronic payment system that allows
19 an individual to store funds and make electronic transactions.

1 * * *

2 "Personal information."

3 (1) An individual's first name or first initial and last
4 name in combination with and linked to any one or more of the
5 following data elements when the data elements are not
6 encrypted or redacted:

7 (i) Social Security number.

8 (ii) Driver's license number or a State
9 identification card number issued in lieu of a driver's
10 license.

11 (iii) Financial account number, credit or debit card
12 number, in combination with any required security code,
13 access code or password that would permit access to an
14 individual's financial account.

15 (iv) Medical information.

16 (v) Health insurance information.

17 (vi) A user name or e-mail address, in combination
18 with a password or security question and answer that
19 would permit access to an online account.

20 (vii) Digital wallet.

21 (2) The term does not include publicly available
22 information that is lawfully made available to the general
23 public from Federal, State or local government records or
24 widely distributed media.

26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
