- 11 (b.1) Human branding. -- The following apply:
- 12 (1) A person commits an offense if he engages in human
- branding of a person under 18 years of age.
- 14 (2) For purposes of this subsection, the term "human"
- branding" shall mean creating a permanent mark on the human
- 16 body by burning the skin with a hot iron or other instrument.

- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
