AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in preliminary provisions, further providing for <-for definitions; IN FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY, PROVIDING FOR 3 NEIGHBORHOOD ELECTRIC VEHICLES; in special vehicles and pedestrians, providing for operation of pedalcycles with electric assist and for regulation and operation of <--7 neighborhood electric vehicles; in other required equipment, further providing for slow moving vehicle emblem; and, in 8 inspection of vehicles, further providing for operation of 9 vehicle without official certificate of inspection. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. The definition of "pedalcycle" in section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended 14 and the section is amended by adding definitions to read: § 102. Definitions. 16 17 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent 18 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific

provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when

- 1 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
- 2 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:
- 3 * * *
- 4 "Neighborhood electric vehicle." A four-wheeled electric
- 5 <u>vehicle that has a maximum design speed of not less than 20</u>
- 6 miles per hour and of not more than 25 miles per hour and that
- 7 complies with the Federal safety standards established in 49 CFR
- 8 <u>571.500</u> (relating to standard no. 500; low-speed vehicles).
- 9 * * *
- 10 "Pedalcycle." A vehicle propelled solely by human-powered
- 11 pedals or a pedalcycle with electric assist. The term does not
- 12 mean a three-wheeled human-powered pedal-driven vehicle with a
- 13 main driving wheel 20 inches in diameter or under and primarily
- 14 designed for children six years of age or younger.
- 15 <u>"Pedalcycle with electric assist." A vehicle weighing not</u>
- 16 more than 100 pounds with two or three wheels more than 11
- 17 inches in diameter, manufactured or assembled with an electric
- 18 motor system rated at not more than 750 watts and equipped with
- 19 operable pedals and capable of a speed not more than 20 miles
- 20 per hour on a level surface when powered by the motor source
- 21 only. The term does not include a device specifically designed
- 22 for use by persons with disabilities.

- 24 § 3591. Scope of subchapter.
- 25 This subchapter applies to the operation of neighborhood
- 26 electric vehicles on certain highways or roadways in this
- 27 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 28 § 3592. Required equipment.
- 29 <u>(a) General rule. A neighborhood electric vehicle operated</u>
- 30 upon any highway or roadway in this Commonwealth shall be

- 1 maintained in proper condition and comply with the equipment
- 2 requirements and standards as set forth in 49 CFR § 571.500
- 3 (relating to standard No. 500; low-speed vehicles). A
- 4 <u>neighborhood electric vehicle operating on any highway or</u>
- 5 roadway shall have a slow moving vehicle emblem affixed in a
- 6 <u>conspicuous place on the rear of the vehicle consistent with</u>
- 7 <u>section 4529 (relating to slow moving vehicle emblem). A</u>
- 8 <u>neighborhood electric vehicle operated upon any highway or</u>
- 9 <u>roadway in this Commonwealth shall be equipped with the</u>

- 13 <u>(3) A speedometer.</u>

- 17 number die stamped upon the engine or motor of the vehicle.

- 20 (b) Exemption. A neighborhood electric vehicle shall be
- 21 <u>exempt from equipment requirements not enumerated in this</u>
- 22 subchapter.
- 23 (c) Penalties. Any person who operates a neighborhood
- 24 electric vehicle without the equipment prescribed in this
- 25 <u>section shall be subject to the penalties under section 6502</u>
- 26 (relating to summary offenses).
- 27 § 3593. Operation on certain highways or roadways.
- 28 (a) General rule. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 29 <u>Chapter 33 (relating to rules of the road in general), a</u>
- 30 neighborhood electric vehicle may be operated only on a highway-

- 1 or roadway with a speed limit of 25 miles per hour or less. A
- 2 neighborhood electric vehicle may not enter an intersection with
- 3 a highway or roadway with a posted speed limit of more than 25
- 4 <u>miles per hour, or cross a highway or roadway with a posted</u>
- 5 speed limit of more than 25 miles per hour, unless traffic on
- 6 that highway or roadway is stopped by a traffic control signal
- 7 at the point the highway is crossed. A neighborhood electric
- 8 vehicle may not cross a divided highway or limited access
- 9 <u>highway.</u>
- 10 (b) Violation. Any person operating a neighborhood electric
- 11 vehicle upon a highway or roadway or crossing a highway or
- 12 roadway in violation of this section shall be subject to the
- 13 penalties under section 6502 (relating to summary offenses).
- 14 § 3594. Licensing, financial responsibility, titling and
- 15 registration.
- 16 A neighborhood electric vehicle shall be considered a
- 17 passenger car for the purposes of Part II (relating to title,
- 18 registration and licensing) and section 4581 (relating to

- 21 A neighborhood electric vehicle may not be operated at a time
- 22 in which the number of passengers exceeds the number of
- 23 available safety belts in the vehicle.

- 26 sunset to sunrise or during periods of decreased visibility.

- 3 on a highway, display on the rear of the vehicle a reflective
- 4 slow moving vehicle emblem as specified in regulations of the
- 5 department. The use of the slow moving vehicle emblem shall be
- 6 in addition to any other lighting devices or equipment required
- 7 by this title.
