1 2 3 4	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in arson, criminal mischief and other property destruction, providing for the offense of interfering with agricultural operations.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 3309.1. Interfering with agricultural operations.
10	(a) Offense defined A person commits the offense of
11	interfering with agricultural operations if the person:
12	(1) Without consent from the owner of an agricultural
13	operation or the owner's agent:
14	(i) records an image of, or sound from, the
15	agricultural operation by leaving a recording device on
16	the agricultural operation; or
17	(ii) uploads, downloads, transfers or otherwise
18	sends recorded images of, or sound from, the agricultural
19	operations over the Internet in any medium.

Т	(2) Obtains access to an agricultural operation under
2	<u>false pretenses.</u>
3	(3) Enters an agricultural operation with the intent to
4	obtain unlawful possession of, or access to, any information,
5	data or article representing any agricultural activity or
6	farming which is conducted or takes place at the agricultural
7	operation.
8	(4) (i) Applies for employment at an agricultural
9	operation with the intent to record an image of, or sound
10	from, the agricultural operation;
11	(ii) knows, at the time that the person accepts
12	employment, that the owner of the agricultural operation
13	prohibits the recording of any image of, or sound from,
14	the agricultural operation; and
15	(iii) while employed at, and while present on, the
16	agricultural operation, records an image of, or sound
17	from, the agricultural operation.
18	(5) Without consent from the owner of the agricultural
19	operation or the owner's agent, records an image of, or sound
20	from, an agricultural operation while the person is
21	committing criminal trespass, as provided for in section 3503
22	(relating to criminal trespass).
23	(b) Grading
24	(1) Except as otherwise provided for in paragraph (2),
25	interfering with agricultural operations is a felony of the
26	third degree.
27	(2) An offense under subsection (a)(3) and (5) is a
28	felony of the second degree.
29	(c) Prosecution not prohibited Prosecution for an offense
30	under this section shall not be construed to prohibit

- 2 (d) Definitions. -- For the purpose of this section, the
- 3 <u>following words and phrases shall have the meanings given to</u>
- 4 them in this subsection unless the context clearly indicates
- 5 <u>otherwise:</u>
- 6 "Agricultural activity" or "farming." Shall have the
- 7 meanings given to them in section 3309 (relating to agricultural
- 8 vandalism).
- 9 <u>"Agricultural operations."</u> Any public or private property
- 10 where an agricultural activity or farming is conducted or takes
- 11 place.
- 12 <u>"Records" or "recording." The process of recording or</u>
- 13 <u>videotaping visual images of, or sound from, an agricultural</u>
- 14 <u>operation</u>.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
