11	Section 1. Section 4(c) of the act of December 19, 1974
12	(P.L.973, No.319), known as the Pennsylvania Farmland and Forest
13	Land Assessment Act of 1974, is amended to read:
14	Section 4. Applications for Preferential Assessments* * *
15	(c) There shall be uniform application forms for
16	preferential assessment in all counties. Such application forms
17	shall be developed by the department. In addition to the
18	information which the department shall deem appropriate, the
19	following [statement] <u>sentences</u> shall be included:
20	"The applicant for preferential assessment hereby agrees, if

his application is approved for preferential assessment, to 1 2 submit thirty days' notice to the county assessor of a proposed 3 change in use of the land, a change in ownership of a portion of the land or of any type of division or conveyance of the land. 4 The applicant for preferential assessment hereby acknowledges 5 that, if his application is approved for preferential 6 7 assessment, roll-back taxes under section 5.1 of the act may be 8 due for a change in use of the land, a change in ownership of any portion of the land, or any type of division or conveyance 9 of the land." 10 11 "As may be required under the act of June 22, 1937 (P.L.1987, 12 No.394), known as The Clean Streams Law, or 25 Pa.
