Section 5329 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 § 5329. Consideration of criminal conviction. 9 * * * (b.1) Rape or incest. No court shall award custody, partial <--10 11 custody or visitation to a parent who is the father of a child-12 conceived as a result of a rape or incest when the child 13 subject of the order, unless the child 14 consents to the order. 15 (B.1) PARENT CONVICTED OF CERTAIN SEXUAL OFFENSES. --<--16 NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (A), NO COURT SHALL

- 4 18 PA.C.S. § 3124.1 WHERE THE OFFENSE INVOLVED SEXUAL
- 5 INTERCOURSE;
- 6 <u>18 PA.C.S. § 3124.2 (RELATING TO INSTITUTIONAL SEXUAL</u>
- 7 ASSAULT) WHERE THE OFFENSE INVOLVED SEXUAL INTERCOURSE; OR
- 8 <u>18 PA.C.S. § 4302,</u>
- 9 UNLESS THE CHILD IS OF SUITABLE AGE AND CONSENTS TO THE ORDER.
- 10 PATERNITY OF THE CHILD SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY BLOOD, GENETIC OR
- 11 OTHER PATERNITY TESTING ACCEPTABLE TO THE COURT.

- 13 SECTION 2. THE ADDITION OF 23 PA.C.S. § 5329(B.1) SHALL <--
- 14 APPLY TO ANY ACTION REGARDING CUSTODY OF A CHILD UNDER 23
