A RESOLUTION

- Designating September 18, 2014, as "Falls and Flu Prevention and Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives notes the importance of
- 4 improving the health, functional abilities and quality of life
- 5 of older adults in our communities; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Annual flu vaccination is the single best way to
- 7 prevent seasonal flu infections and serious flu-related
- 8 illnesses; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Because early vaccination is associated with greater
- 10 health benefits, getting vaccinated as soon as a vaccine becomes
- 11 available is recommended as an effective flu prevention
- 12 strategy; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Older adults, especially persons with weakened
- 14 immune function or chronic health conditions, are susceptible to
- 15 flu complications resulting in hospitalization or death; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Vaccine options for older adults include a standard-
- 2 dose vaccine and a more protective higher-dose vaccine; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Improving vaccination rates is an important public
- 4 health goal in the Philadelphia area, where rates have fallen
- 5 below the national average; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Preventing falls is another public health challenge
- 7 in our communities; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Falls are a leading cause of fatal and nonfatal
- 9 injuries among older adults; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The risk of falling increases with each decade of
- 11 life; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Maintaining vision, balance and mobility, reviewing
- 13 medication use and ensuring home safety are some goals of fall
- 14 prevention; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Enlisting the support of family members and
- 16 caregivers helps when addressing modifiable fall risk factors;
- 17 and
- 18 WHEREAS, Center in the Park in Germantown is a nonprofit
- 19 community center serving senior residents of northwest
- 20 Philadelphia; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Center in the Park is participating in the National
- 22 Council on Aging's Flu + You program; therefore be it
- 23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 24 September 18, 2014, as "Falls and Flu Prevention and Awareness
- 25 Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
