A RESOLUTION

- Declaring support for the State of Israel, recognizing the geopolitical challenges Israel faces and highlighting the 2 special relationship that has existed between the United States of America and Israel since the inception of Israel as a nation. 5 WHEREAS, On May 14, 1948, the establishment of an independent 6 Jewish state to be known as the State of Israel was declared; 8 and 9 WHEREAS, The United States of America and Israel have a 10 unique bond based on their shared, enduring values, which are 11 reflected in the virtues and principles of freedom and 12 democracy, and have stood together as allies since Israel was 13 first formed as a nation; and 14 WHEREAS, The Jewish people have deep historical and cultural 15 ties that began many centuries ago to the ancient lands in the
- 17 WHEREAS, The State of Israel is unique as a truly democratic

geographic region where their nation is situated; and

- 2 neighboring countries that openly and repeatedly call for
- 3 Israel's total destruction; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Israeli civilians continue to be targets of
- 5 terroristic violence at home and in other locations around the
- 6 world simply by virtue of their Israeli citizenship; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Israel has an inherent right to protect the security
- 8 of its civilian population in self-defense from terrorist
- 9 attacks and from the threats of conventional and nuclear war and
- 10 to defend its borders as a sovereign nation; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Throughout generations in the history of the Jewish
- 12 people, suffering and various persecutions have been visited
- 13 upon them as an ethnic group somewhere in the world; and
- 14 WHEREAS, During the years of 1941 to 1945, the Jewish people
- 15 suffered the horrors of the Holocaust, as nearly 6,000,000
- 16 European Jews died during the oppressive reign of the German
- 17 Nazi Regime; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The nation of Iran has continued to attempt to build
- 19 an illicit nuclear weapons program, which presents a direct and
- 20 serious threat to the security of Israel, among other nations
- 21 around the world including the United States homeland; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Today, Israel is faced with the prospect of a second
- 23 holocaust, as they are threatened by repeated public
- 24 declarations of complete annihilation by neighboring countries
- 25 which are hostile to the very existence of the Jewish nation and
- 26 have sworn to achieve Israel's total destruction; and
- 27 WHEREAS, The same countries that are hostile toward the State
- 28 of Israel share a similar enmity toward the United States and
- 29 have similarly vowed to achieve the total destruction of America
- 30 and our way of life; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The Jewish people have vowed that "never again" will
- 2 there be another holocaust and the Israeli government is
- 3 dedicated to forever securing the safety and prosperity of its
- 4 people for generations to come; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The State of Israel is committed to achieving a
- 6 lasting peace with its neighbors through peaceful negotiations;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, In the face of continued threats of violence and
- 9 hostility by such entities, the Israelis are pledged to doing
- 10 everything possible to ensure the survival of their people; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The United States of America and Israel continue to
- 12 be close allies and are committed to supporting one another as
- 13 free, democratic peoples; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The State of Israel stands as a beacon of hope in
- 15 the Middle East for the principles of freedom and democracy and
- 16 the Israeli government continues to seek peace for all peoples
- 17 through constructive negotiation and agreement; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare its
- 19 undivided support for the State of Israel, recognize the special
- 20 relationship that exists between the United States of America
- 21 and Israel and offer its undivided support for the Israeli
- 22 government's right to defend its sovereign borders and citizens
- 23 from terroristic threats and from the threats of conventional
- 24 and nuclear war.
