## A RESOLUTION

Recognizing the week of April 14 through 20, 2013, as the "Week 1 2 of the Young Child" in Pennsylvania. 3 WHEREAS, As part of the "Week of the Young Child" celebrated across the United States, Pennsylvania is honoring young 4 5 children and all those who make a difference in children's 6 lives; and 7 WHEREAS, Young children and their families depend on highquality education and care, which help children get a great 8 9 start and bring lasting benefits to our community; and 10 WHEREAS, The "Week of the Young Child" is a time to recognize 11 the importance of early learning and early literacy and to 12 celebrate the teachers and policies that bring early childhood education to young children; and 13

1 WHEREAS, The National Association for the Education of Young 2 Children has chosen "Early Years Are Learning Years" as the 2013 3 theme of the "Week of the Young Child," due to the importance of 4 children's earliest years in shaping their learning and 5 development; and

6 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth is adopting this resolution in 7 order to recognize the efforts of the preschool programs and 8 teaching staff in Pennsylvania who are working daily to improve the professional practice and working conditions in early 9 10 childhood education and to build public support for high-quality early childhood education programs; therefore be it 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 12 13 week of April 14 through 20, 2013, as the "Week of the Young 14 Child" in Pennsylvania.
