A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the month of January 2024 as "School Director Recognition Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, This Commonwealth recognizes the public service of
4	its 4,500 locally elected school directors who carry out
5	voluntary public service to advance student achievement and
6	well-being in the districts and communities they serve; and
7	WHEREAS, School directors are responsible for providing
8	leadership that ensures a clear, shared vision of public
9	education for their schools, sets high standards for the
10	education of all students and requires the effective and
11	efficient operation of their districts; and
12	WHEREAS, The work of school directors is complex and diverse
13	as they establish local policies, approve educational programs,
14	provide necessary physical facilities, hire qualified employees
15	and share along with the Commonwealth the burden of being fiscal
16	stewards of taxpayer dollars to operate district educational

1 programs with transparency and accountability; and

2 WHEREAS, School directors are steadfast advocates for public 3 education and are responsible for communicating the needs of the 4 school district and students with Federal, State and local 5 leaders; and

6 WHEREAS, School board service is an honor that carries 7 significant responsibility to students, parents, district staff, 8 fellow board members and the larger community; therefore be it 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 10 month of January 2024 as "School Director Recognition Month" in 11 Pennsylvania; and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to13 the Pennsylvania School Boards Association.
