- Designating May 2014 as "Community Action Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Community action agencies were created when the
- 4 Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 (Public Law 88-452, 42 U.S.C. §
- 5 2701 et seq.) was signed into law; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Community action agencies have a 50-year history of
- 7 promoting self-sufficiency for individuals with limited income;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, Community action agencies have made an essential
- 10 contribution to individuals and families in Pennsylvania by
- 11 providing them with innovative and cost-effective programs; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Community action agencies are needed as major
- 13 participants in the reform of the welfare system as we know it;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, Welfare reform in Pennsylvania has benefited from

- 1 the Commonwealth's partnership with community action agencies;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, Low-income Pennsylvanians continue to need
- 4 opportunities to improve their lives and their living conditions
- 5 in order that all citizens are able to live in dignity; and
- 6 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth and the rest of the nation must
- 7 continue to promote economic security by providing support and
- 8 opportunities for all citizens in need of assistance; therefore
- 9 be it

- 11 50th Anniversary of Community Action, designate May 2014 as
- 12 "Community Action Month" in Pennsylvania in recognition of the
