AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in Pennsylvania Game Commission, further providing
- for organization of commission.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 301(a) and (b) introductory paragraph of
- 7 Title 34 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended
- 8 and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 301. Organization of commission.
- 10 (a) Composition. -- The independent administrative commission
- 11 known as the Pennsylvania Game Commission shall consist of
- 12 [nine] 10 competent citizens of this Commonwealth who shall be
- 13 well informed on the subject of wildlife conservation and
- 14 restoration and who shall be appointed by the Governor, by and
- 15 with the advice and consent of a majority of the elected members
- 16 of the Senate.
- 17 (b) Qualifications.--[The] One member of the commission
- 18 shall be known as the Agricultural Commissioner At Large. The
- 19 Agricultural Commissioner At Large shall represent the interest

- 1 of agricultural commodities that pertain to normal agricultural_
- 2 operations and wildlife. The remaining members of the commission
- 3 shall be appointed from the various geographical sections of
- 4 this Commonwealth so that one and only one shall be a resident
- 5 of each of the following districts:

- 7 (e) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 8 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 9 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 10 "Agricultural Commissioner At Large." An individual who
- 11 raises an agricultural commodity and who owns or leases a normal
- 12 <u>agricultural operation</u>.
- 13 "Agricultural commodity." As defined in section 2 of the act
- 14 <u>of June 10, 1982 (P.L.454, No.133), entitled "An act protecting</u>
- 15 <u>agricultural operations from nuisance suits and ordinances under</u>
- 16 certain circumstances."
- 17 <u>"Normal agricultural operation."</u> As defined in section 2 of
- 18 the act of June 10, 1982 (P.L.454, No.133), entitled "An act
- 19 protecting agricultural operations from nuisance suits and
- 20 ordinances under certain circumstances."
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
