5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 ~~Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated~~ <--

8 ~~§ 1355.1. Pennsylvania hunting heritage plate.~~

9 ~~The department, in consultation with the Pennsylvania Game~~

10 ~~Commission, shall design a hunting heritage plate. Upon~~

11 ~~application of any person, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which~~

12 ~~shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, the~~

13 ~~department shall issue the plate for a passenger car, motor~~

14 ~~home, trailer or truck with a registered gross weight of not~~

15 ~~more than 14,000 pounds. Fifteen dollars of the fee shall be~~

16 ~~deposited into the Pennsylvania Hunting Heritage Fund and~~

23 § 1307. PERIOD OF REGISTRATION.

24 * * *

25 (A.1) SEASONAL REGISTRATION.--UPON APPLICATION ON A FORM
26 PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE OWNER OR LESSEE OF A PASSENGER
27 CAR, RECREATIONAL MOTOR VEHICLE, MOTORCYCLE, TRUCK OR FARM
28 VEHICLE WHICH DOES NOT HAVE A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING OF
29 MORE THAN [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS MAY REGISTER THE VEHICLE WITH
30 THE DEPARTMENT FOR A PERIOD OF SUCCESSIVE MONTHS OF LESS THAN
31 ONE YEAR. THE APPLICANT SHALL SPECIFY THE PERIOD OF MONTHS

1 DURING WHICH THE VEHICLE SHALL BE REGISTERED. EXCEPT WHEN THE
2 DEPARTMENT INITIALLY CONVERTS A CURRENTLY VALID ANNUAL
3 REGISTRATION TO A SEASONAL REGISTRATION, THE ANNUAL FEE
4 PRESCRIBED FOR THE VEHICLE BY CHAPTER 19 (RELATING TO FEES)
5 SHALL BE PAID IN FULL BY THE APPLICANT REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER
6 OF MONTHS CHOSEN FOR REGISTRATION BY THE APPLICANT. UPON RECEIPT
7 OF THE APPROPRIATE FEE AND THE PROPERLY COMPLETED FORM,
8 INCLUDING ALL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS CHAPTER, THE
9 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A SEASONAL REGISTRATION THAT SHALL EXPIRE
10 ON THE LAST DAY OF THE EXPIRATION MONTH CHOSEN BY THE
11 REGISTRANT. NO INSURER OF A VEHICLE BELONGING TO ANY OWNER OR
12 LESSEE WHO OBTAINS A SEASONAL REGISTRATION AND WHO APPLIES FOR
13 OR RECEIVES A REDUCED AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE PREMIUM ON ACCOUNT
14 THEREOF SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE ANY CONTRACTUAL COVERAGE,
15 WHETHER IN THE FORM OF THE PROVISION OF A DEFENSE OR THE PAYMENT
16 OF FIRST-PARTY OR THIRD-PARTY BENEFITS OR OTHERWISE, TO THE
17 OWNER OR LESSEE IN CONNECTION WITH ANY EVENT OCCURRING DURING
18 THAT PART OF THE YEAR IN WHICH THE VEHICLE IS NOT REGISTERED;
19 AND SUCH OWNER OR LESSEE SHALL BE TREATED FOR ALL PURPOSES,
20 INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ASCERTAINING RIGHTS TO STACK
21 COVERAGES AND TO UNINSURED AND UNDERINSURED MOTORIST COVERAGE,
22 AS A PERSON WHO DOES NOT OWN THAT VEHICLE AND HAS NO DUTY TO
23 CARRY FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY ON IT FOR THAT PART OF THE YEAR.

25 § 1338. PERSON WITH DISABILITY PLATE AND PLACARD.

26 (A) PERSON WITH DISABILITY PLATE.--ON THE APPLICATION OF ANY
27 PERSON WHO:

28 (1) IS BLIND;

29 (2) DOES NOT HAVE FULL USE OF AN ARM OR BOTH ARMS;

30 (3) CANNOT WALK 200 FEET WITHOUT STOPPING TO REST;

1 (4) CANNOT WALK WITHOUT THE USE OF, OR ASSISTANCE FROM,
2 A BRACE, CANE, CRUTCH, ANOTHER PERSON, PROSTHETIC DEVICE,
3 WHEELCHAIR OR OTHER ASSISTIVE DEVICE;

4 (5) IS RESTRICTED BY LUNG DISEASE TO SUCH AN EXTENT THAT
5 THE PERSON'S FORCED (RESPIRATORY) EXPIRATORY VOLUME FOR ONE
6 SECOND, WHEN MEASURED BY SPIROMETRY, IS LESS THAN ONE LITER
7 OR THE ARTERIAL OXYGEN TENSION IS LESS THAN 60 MM/HG ON ROOM
8 AIR AT REST;

9 (6) USES PORTABLE OXYGEN;

10 (7) HAS A CARDIAC CONDITION TO THE EXTENT THAT THE
11 PERSON'S FUNCTIONAL LIMITATIONS ARE CLASSIFIED IN SEVERITY AS
12 CLASS III OR CLASS IV ACCORDING TO THE STANDARDS SET BY THE
13 AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION;

14 (8) IS SEVERELY LIMITED IN HIS OR HER ABILITY TO WALK
15 DUE TO AN ARTHRITIC, NEUROLOGICAL OR ORTHOPEDIC CONDITION; OR

16 (9) IS A PERSON IN LOCO PARENTIS OF A PERSON SPECIFIED
17 IN PARAGRAPH (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) OR (8);

18 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE
19 FOR ONE PASSENGER CAR OR TRUCK WITH A REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT
20 OF NOT MORE THAN [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS, DESIGNATING THE
21 VEHICLE SO LICENSED AS BEING USED BY A PERSON WITH A
22 DISABILITY. SPECIAL PLATES FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES MAY
23 ALSO BE ISSUED FOR VEHICLES OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE USE
24 AND BENEFIT OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES. IN THE CASE OF A
25 MOTORCYCLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A DECAL CONTAINING THE
26 INTERNATIONAL SYMBOL FOR ACCESS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES
27 FOR DISPLAY ON THE REGISTRATION PLATE.

29 § 1340. ANTIQUE, CLASSIC AND COLLECTIBLE PLATES.

1 (A.1) VINTAGE REGISTRATION PLATES.--IN LIEU OF A SPECIAL
2 PLATE ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (A), THE OWNER OF AN ANTIQUE OR
3 CLASSIC MOTOR VEHICLE MAY REQUEST PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT
4 TO DISPLAY A VINTAGE REGISTRATION PLATE FROM THE MODEL YEAR OF
5 THE MOTOR VEHICLE. THE VINTAGE REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL BE:

7 (2) A PENNSYLVANIA REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED BETWEEN THE
8 YEARS 1906 AND [1975] 1976.

10 § 1342. VETERAN PLATES AND PLACARD.

11 (A) SEVERELY DISABLED VETERAN PLATE.--ON THE APPLICATION OF
12 A VETERAN WHOSE SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY IS CERTIFIED AT
13 100% BY THE SERVICE UNIT OF THE ARMED FORCES IN WHICH THE
14 VETERAN SERVED OR BY THE UNITED STATES VETERANS' ADMINISTRATION
15 OR WHO HAS A SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY OF THE TYPE ENUMERATED
16 IN SECTION 1338 (RELATING TO PERSON WITH DISABILITY PLATE AND
17 PLACARD), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A SPECIAL REGISTRATION
18 PLATE DESIGNATING THE VEHICLE AS BELONGING TO A SEVERELY
19 DISABLED VETERAN. THE REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL HAVE A WHITE
20 BACKGROUND, SHALL HAVE BLUE NUMBERS OR LETTERS AS THE DEPARTMENT
21 MAY DETERMINE, SHALL HAVE THE WORDS "DISABLED VETERAN" IN AT
22 LEAST TEN-POINT BOLD TYPE INSCRIBED IN RED AT THE BOTTOM OF THE
23 PLATE AND SHALL INCLUDE THE INTERNATIONAL SYMBOL FOR ACCESS FOR
24 PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES. [ONLY ONE] A SPECIAL REGISTRATION
25 PLATE [SHALL BE] ISSUED TO A VETERAN UNDER THIS SECTION[. IT]
26 MAY BE USED ONLY ON A PASSENGER CAR OR TRUCK WITH A REGISTERED
27 GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT MORE THAN [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS. IN THE
28 CASE OF A MOTORCYCLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A DECAL
29 CONTAINING THE INTERNATIONAL SYMBOL FOR ACCESS FOR PERSONS WITH
30 DISABILITIES AND THE WORDS "DISABLED VETERAN" FOR DISPLAY ON THE

1 REGISTRATION PLATE.

3 (C) DISABLED VETERAN PLATES.--ON THE APPLICATION OF ANY
4 VETERAN HAVING A DISABILITY CERTIFIED BY THE SERVICE UNIT OF THE
5 ARMED FORCES IN WHICH THE VETERAN SERVED OR BY THE UNITED STATES
6 VETERANS' ADMINISTRATION AS SERVICE-CONNECTED, THE DEPARTMENT
7 SHALL ISSUE A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE DESIGNATING THE VEHICLE
8 AS BELONGING TO A DISABLED VETERAN. THE REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL
9 HAVE A WHITE BACKGROUND, SHALL HAVE NUMBERS OR LETTERS AS THE
10 DEPARTMENT MAY DETERMINE AND SHALL HAVE THE WORDS "DISABLED
11 VETERAN" IN AT LEAST TEN-POINT BOLD TYPE INSCRIBED AT THE BOTTOM
12 OF THE PLATE. [ONLY ONE] A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE [SHALL BE]
13 ISSUED TO A VETERAN UNDER THIS SECTION[. IT] MAY BE USED ONLY ON
14 A PASSENGER CAR OR TRUCK WITH A REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT
15 MORE THAN [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS.

16 (D) PRISONER OF WAR PLATE.--ON THE APPLICATION OF AN EX-
17 PRISONER OF WAR WHOSE IMPRISONMENT WHILE IN THE SERVICE OF THE
18 ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES IS CERTIFIED BY THE
19 APPROPRIATE BRANCH OF THE ARMED FORCES, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
20 ISSUE A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE DESIGNATING THE VEHICLE AS
21 BELONGING TO AN EX-PRISONER OF WAR. THE REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL
22 CONTAIN THE LETTERS "POW" AND SUCH OTHER NUMBERS OR LETTERS AS
23 THE DEPARTMENT MAY DETERMINE AND SHALL HAVE THE WORDS "PRISONER
24 OF WAR" IN AT LEAST TEN-POINT BOLD TYPE INSCRIBED AT THE BOTTOM
25 OF THE PLATE. [ONLY ONE] A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE [SHALL BE]
26 ISSUED TO AN EX-PRISONER OF WAR UNDER THIS SUBSECTION[. THE
27 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE] MAY BE USED ONLY ON A PASSENGER CAR
28 OR TRUCK WITH A REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT MORE THAN
29 [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS.

1 § 1346. SPECIAL PLATES FOR RECIPIENTS OF PURPLE HEART.

2 UPON APPLICATION OF ANY PERSON WHO IS A RECIPIENT OF THE
3 PURPLE HEART, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE TO SUCH PERSON A
4 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE DESIGNATING THE VEHICLE SO LICENSED
5 AS BELONGING TO A PERSON WHO IS A RECIPIENT OF THE PURPLE HEART.
6 A SEVERELY DISABLED VETERAN, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1342(A)
7 (RELATING TO VETERAN PLATES AND PLACARD), WHO IS QUALIFIED TO
8 RECEIVE A PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION MAY ALSO ELECT TO RECEIVE A
9 PLACARD UNDER SECTION 1342(B). THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE
10 MAY BE USED ONLY ON A PASSENGER CAR OR TRUCK WITH A REGISTERED
11 GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT MORE THAN [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS.

12 § 1348. SPECIAL PLATES FOR PEARL HARBOR SURVIVORS.

13 UPON APPLICATION OF ANY PERSON WHO IS A SURVIVOR OF PEARL
14 HARBOR, ACCOMPANIED BY A FEE OF \$20 WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION
15 TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE AND BY SUCH DOCUMENTATION AS THE
16 DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE TO SUCH
17 PERSON A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE DESIGNATING THE VEHICLE SO
18 LICENSED AS BELONGING TO A PERSON WHO IS A SURVIVOR OF PEARL
19 HARBOR. THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE MAY BE USED ONLY ON A
20 PASSENGER CAR OR TRUCK WITH A REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT
21 MORE THAN [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS.

22 § 1350. SPECIAL PLATES FOR VETERANS OF KOREAN WAR.

23 UPON APPLICATION OF ANY PERSON WHO IS A VETERAN OF THE KOREAN
24 WAR, ACCOMPANIED BY A FEE OF \$20, WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO
25 THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE, AND BY SUCH DOCUMENTATION AS THE
26 DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE TO THE
27 PERSON A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE DESIGNATING THE VEHICLE SO
28 LICENSED AS BELONGING TO A PERSON WHO IS A VETERAN OF THE KOREAN
29 WAR. THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE MAY BE USED ONLY ON A
30 PASSENGER CAR OR TRUCK WITH A REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT

2 § 1350.1. SPECIAL PLATES FOR RECIPIENTS OF KOREAN DEFENSE
3 SERVICE MEDAL.

4 UPON APPLICATION OF ANY PERSON WHO IS A RECIPIENT OF THE
5 KOREAN DEFENSE SERVICE MEDAL, ACCOMPANIED BY A FEE OF \$20 WHICH
6 SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE AND BY SUCH
7 DOCUMENTATION AS THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE, THE DEPARTMENT
8 SHALL ISSUE TO THE PERSON A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE
9 DESIGNATING THE VEHICLE SO LICENSED AS BELONGING TO A PERSON WHO
10 IS A RECIPIENT OF THE KOREAN DEFENSE SERVICE MEDAL. THE
11 DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGN AND PRODUCE THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION
12 PLATE. THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE MAY BE USED ONLY ON A
13 PASSENGER CAR OR TRUCK WITH A REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT
14 MORE THAN [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS.

15 § 1351. SPECIAL PLATES FOR VETERANS OF PERSIAN GULF WAR.

16 UPON APPLICATION OF ANY PERSON WHO IS A VETERAN OF THE
17 PERSIAN GULF WAR, ACCOMPANIED BY A FEE OF \$20, WHICH SHALL BE IN
18 ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE, AND BY SUCH
19 DOCUMENTATION AS THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE, THE DEPARTMENT
20 SHALL ISSUE TO THE PERSON A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE
21 DESIGNATING THE VEHICLE SO LICENSED AS BELONGING TO A PERSON WHO
22 IS A VETERAN OF THE PERSIAN GULF WAR. THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION
23 PLATE MAY BE USED ONLY ON A PASSENGER CAR OR TRUCK WITH A
24 REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT MORE THAN [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS.

25 § 1352. WILD RESOURCE CONSERVATION PLATE.

26 THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE WILD RESOURCE
27 CONSERVATION BOARD, SHALL DESIGN A SPECIAL WILD RESOURCE
28 CONSERVATION REGISTRATION PLATE. UPON APPLICATION OF ANY PERSON,
29 ACCOMPANIED BY A FEE OF \$35 WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO THE
30 ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE THE PLATE

1 FOR A PASSENGER CAR, MOTOR HOME, TRAILER OR TRUCK WITH A
2 REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT MORE THAN [10,000] 14,000 POUNDS.
3 THE WILD RESOURCE CONSERVATION FUND SHALL RECEIVE \$15 OF EACH
4 ADDITIONAL FEE FOR THIS PLATE.

6 2014 (P.L.361, NO.23), IS AMENDED TO READ:

7 § 1352.1. APPALACHIAN TRAIL ORGANIZATION REGISTRATION PLATES.

8 (A) GENERAL RULE.--THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE
9 APPALACHIAN TRAIL CONSERVANCY, SHALL DESIGN A SPECIAL
10 APPALACHIAN TRAIL ORGANIZATION REGISTRATION PLATE. THE PLATE, AT
11 A MINIMUM, SHALL CONTAIN THE IMAGE OF A HIKER AND THE
12 APPALACHIAN TRAIL CONSERVANCY LOGO AND DISTINCTIVE COLORING. THE
13 APPALACHIAN TRAIL CONSERVANCY MAY CHARGE A FEE FOR THE
14 AUTHORIZATION TO REQUEST THE REGISTRATION PLATE. UPON REQUEST BY
15 THE APPLICANT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE THE PLATE FOR A
16 PASSENGER CAR OR TRUCK WITH A REGISTERED GROSS WEIGHT OF NOT
17 MORE THAN 14,000 POUNDS OR A MOTOR HOME. THE FEE PROVIDED UNDER
18 SECTION [1931] 1931(B) (RELATING TO PERSONAL AND ORGANIZATION
19 REGISTRATION PLATES) SHALL APPLY.
