## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles, further providing for definitions.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. The definition of "all-terrain vehicle" or "ATV"
7	in section 7702 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 7702. Definitions.
10	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
11	shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
12	meanings given to them in this section:
13	"All-terrain vehicle" or "ATV." A motorized off-highway
14	vehicle which travels on three or more [inflatable] off-highway
15	tires and which has:
16	(1) a maximum width of 50 inches and a maximum dry
17	weight of [1,000] <u>1,200</u> pounds; or
18	(2) a width which exceeds 50 inches or a dry weight

1 which exceeds [1,000] <u>1,200</u> pounds.

2 ATV's described in paragraph (1) may be referred to as Class I 3 ATV's, and ATV's described in paragraph (2) may be referred to as Class II ATV's. This term does not include snowmobiles, trail 4 bikes, motorboats, golf carts, aircraft, dune buggies, 5 automobiles, construction machines, trucks or home utility 6 7 machines; military, fire, emergency and law enforcement 8 vehicles; implements of husbandry; multipurpose agricultural vehicles; vehicles used by the department; or any vehicle that 9 10 is or is required to be registered under Chapter 13 (relating to registration of vehicles). In addition, this term does not 11 12 include off-road motor vehicles used exclusively as utility 13 vehicles for agricultural or business operations and 14 incidentally operated or moved upon the highway. 15 \* \* \*

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
