## AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled
  "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration
  thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery
  Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of
  funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes
  from State and local taxation and making an appropriation,"
  in State Lottery, further providing for powers and duties of
  secretary.
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. Section 303(a)(11)(iv) of the act of August 26,
- 12 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State Lottery Law, amended
- 13 June 30, 2011 (P.L.110, No.23), is amended to read:
- 14 Section 303. Powers and duties of secretary.
- 15 (a) Powers and duties enumerated. -- In addition to the powers
- 16 and duties provided by law and the act of April 9, 1929
- 17 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, the
- 18 secretary shall have the power and it shall be his duty to
- 19 operate and administer the lottery, and to promulgate rules and
- 20 regulations governing the establishment and operation thereof,

3 (11) The apportionment of the total revenues accruing 4 from the sale of lottery tickets or shares and from all other 5 sources among:

7 (iv) for property tax relief and free or reduced 8 fare transit service for the elderly as provided in 9 section 311. For fiscal years beginning [before July 1, 2015] <u>after June 30, 2014</u>, no less than [27%] <u>25%</u> of the 10 total revenues accruing from the sale of lottery tickets 11 12 or shares shall be dedicated to this subparagraph. [For 13 fiscal years beginning after June 30, 2015, no less than 14 30% of the total revenues accruing from the sale of 15 lottery tickets or shares shall be dedicated to this 16 subparagraph.]

  19 Pa. Code § 803.11(11)(iv) is abrogated to the extent that the

  20 regulation is inconsistent with this act.
- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
