- 1 Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in public works contracts, providing for recreation
- and fitness equipment.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 62 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 3914. Recreation and fitness equipment.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Whenever a local government unit intends
- 10 to procure recreation or fitness equipment and the installation
- 11 thereof, the local government unit may calculate the entire
- 12 cost, value or amount of the equipment separately from that of
- 13 the installation in order to determine whether the procurement
- 14 is subject to the competitive bid requirements of any law
- 15 <u>relating to the local government unit.</u>
- 16 (b) Intergovernmental relations. -- The department may not
- 17 exclude a local government unit from participating as a local
- 18 government procurement unit, as defined in section 1901
- 19 (relating to definitions), in a cooperative purchasing program

- 1 <u>administered by the department under Chapter 19 (relating to</u>
- 2 <u>intergovernmental relations</u>) because the local government unit
- 3 intends to solicit separate bids for recreation or fitness
- 4 equipment and the installation thereof as authorized under this
- 5 section.
- 6 (c) Applicability. -- This section applies to any contract
- 7 regardless of the dollar amount and the definition of "contract"
- 8 in section 3902 (relating to definitions).
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
