9	Section 1. Section 6011(b) of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
10	Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
11	adding a subsection to read:
12	§ 6011. Affordable housing programs fee in counties.

14	(b) LimitationThe additional fees levied by a governing
15	body of a county under subsection (a) shall not exceed 100% of
16	the amounts charged [on February 12, 1993.] <u>by the county for</u>
17	recording deeds and mortgages.
18	(c) ConstructionSubsection (a) shall not limit or
19	otherwise impact the authority of a county to alter the fees
20	levied by the county as of the effective date of this subsection

1 for recording deeds and mortgages.

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2	Section 2. Subchapter C of Chapter 60 of Title 53 is amended
3	by adding sections to read:

5	(a) County reportingBeginning July 1, 2023, and no later
6	than each July 1 thereafter, a county collecting proceeds as a
7	result of the fee levied under section 6011(a) (relating to
8	affordable housing programs fee in counties) shall submit an
9	annual report to the advisory committee established under
10	section 6015 (relating to Pennsylvania Affordable Housing
11	Advisory Committee) on a form and in a manner prescribed by the
12	<u>Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency.</u>
13	(b) Content of reportsEach annual report required under
14	subsection (a) shall contain all of the following information
15	for the preceding fiscal year:
16	(1) The total amount of money collected by the county as
17	<u>a result of the fee under section 6011(a) and the total</u>
18	amount allocated by the county from that money.
19	(2) Amounts and descriptions of the county's allocations
20	made from money collected as a result of the fee levied under
21	<u>section 6011(a) to a separate account for the purpose of</u>
22	funding affordable housing efforts as described in section
23	6012(b)(1) (relating to disposition of proceeds in counties).
24	(3) Amounts and descriptions of the county's allocations
25	made from money collected as a result of the fee levied under
26	section 6011(a) for the purpose of covering administrative
27	costs associated with the affordable housing efforts as
28	described in section 6012(b)(2).
29	(4) A description of the county's affordable housing
30	efforts funded by the money collected by the county as a

5	(c) Duties of Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency
6	(1) The Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency shall
7	prescribe the form and manner of the annual reports required
8	<u>under subsection (a).</u>
9	(2) Annual reports submitted under this section shall be
10	posted to the publicly accessible Internet website of the
11	<u>Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency.</u>
12	<u>§ 6015. Pennsylvania Affordable Housing Advisory Committee.</u>
13	(a) EstablishmentThe Pennsylvania Affordable Housing
14	Advisory Committee is established within the Pennsylvania
15	Housing Finance Agency.
16	(b) CompositionThe advisory committee shall consist of
17	the following members:
18	(1) The Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Housing
19	Finance Agency or a designee. The designee under this
20	paragraph must be an employee of the Pennsylvania Housing
21	Finance Agency. The Executive Director or designee shall
22	serve as the chairperson of the advisory committee.
23	(2) The following individuals to be appointed by the
24	<u>Governor within 30 days of the effective date of this</u>
25	paragraph:
26	(i) Six individuals who:
27	(A) represent the counties collecting proceeds
28	as a result of the fee levied under section 6011(a)

7	Alliance of Pennsylvania.
8	(iii) One individual representing the Pennsylvania
9	chapter of the American Institute of Architects.
10	(iv) One individual representing residential real
11	<u>estate developers.</u>
12	(v) One individual representing construction trades.
13	(vi) One individual representing mortgage lenders.
14	(vii) One individual representing the interests of
15	persons with disabilities.
16	(viii) One individual representing home builders.
17	(ix) One individual representing neighborhood
18	groups.
19	(x) One individual representing low-income families.
20	(xi) One individual representing service providers
21	serving low-income families.
22	(xii) One individual representing nonprofit
23	community-based organizations and community development
24	corporations.
25	(xiii) One individual representing real estate
26	brokers or salespersons.
27	(xiv) One individual representing apartment owners.
28	(xv) One individual representing renters.
29	(xvi) One individual representing the manufactured
30	housing industry.

1	(c) Quorum and voting
2	(1) Nine members of the advisory committee shall
3	<u>constitute a quorum.</u>
4	(2) A vote of the majority of the members of the
5	advisory committee shall prevail.
6	(d) Terms
7	(1) The Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Housing
8	Finance Agency shall serve as a member and the chairperson of
9	the advisory committee if that individual continues to serve
10	in the official capacity of Executive Director.
11	(2) Advisory committee members appointed under
12	subsection (b)(2) shall be appointed to staggered three-year
13	terms, as determined by the Governor. An advisory committee
14	member may be reappointed for an additional term.
15	(3) As follows:
16	(i) Subject to subparagraph (ii), an advisory
17	committee member whose term expires shall continue as a
18	member of the advisory committee until a replacement has
19	been appointed. The member shall have full voting rights
20	and count for purposes of establishing a quorum.
21	(ii) A member may not continue to serve on the
22	advisory committee beyond six months from the date of the
23	expiration of the member's term.
24	(4) An individual appointed to fill a vacancy on the
25	advisory committee under subsection (e) shall serve for the
26	unexpired term and shall be eligible for reappointment.
27	(e) VacanciesIf a vacancy occurs on the advisory
28	committee, the Governor shall appoint a successor member within
29	30 days of the vacancy.
30	(f) MeetingsThe advisory committee shall meet in

2	(1) Advisory committee members shall meet no fewer than
3	four times per year on a quarterly basis, but may hold
4	additional meetings as are called by the chairperson of the
5	advisory committee.
6	(2) The agenda for each meeting of the advisory
7	committee and all meeting minutes of the advisory committee
8	shall be posted on the publicly accessible Internet website
9	of the Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency. Information
10	regarding the agendas and minutes shall be accessible for
11	inspection and duplication in accordance with the act of
12	February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know
13	Law.
14	(3) Meetings of the advisory committee shall comply with
15	65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating to open meetings).
16	(g) Compensation and reimbursement
17	(1) Advisory committee members shall not be entitled to
18	compensation for their service as advisory committee members.
19	(2) Advisory committee members shall be entitled to
20	reimbursement in accordance with Commonwealth guidelines for
21	reasonable travel, lodging and other necessary expenses
22	incurred in the performance of their duties as advisory
23	<u>committee members.</u>
24	(h) PowersThe advisory committee shall have the power to
25	advise and consult the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania
26	Housing Finance Agency and counties collecting proceeds as a
27	result of the fee levied under section 6011(a) on affordable
28	housing efforts as defined in section 6013 (relating to
29	affordable housing efforts in counties) and how to expand or
30	improve affordable housing efforts.

1 (i) Duties.--The advisory committee shall have the following 2 duties: (1) To meet to share, study and consider challenges to 3 county affordable housing efforts in addition to existing and 4 5 new affordable housing efforts that demonstrate success in increasing access to affordable housing in the counties. 6 (2) To review the most recent annual reports submitted 7 by the counties under section 6014 (relating to reporting 8 9 requirements). (3) Beginning no later than January 1, 2024, and by each 10 January 1 thereafter, to provide an annual report to the 11 12 chairperson and minority chairperson of the Urban Affairs and 13 Housing Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and 14 minority chairperson of the Urban Affairs Committee of the House of Representatives. 3	publicly accessible Internet website of the Pennsylvania
4	Housing Finance Agency.
5	(j) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
6	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
7	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
8	"Advisory committee." The Pennsylvania Affordable Housing
9	Advisory Committee established under subsection (a).
10	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
