Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for examination of applicant for driver's license; and, in 2 3 motorcycles, further providing for motorcycle safety 4 education program. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Sections 1508 and 7911 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding subsections to read: 10 § 1508. Examination of applicant for driver's license. 11 12 13 (d.1) Legal quardianship awareness. -- The driver's manual 14 shall include a section with the following statement: 15 "Just as motor vehicle insurance protects you financially 16 when an accident happens, designating who should serve as a 17 legal quardian, or possess power of attorney, can protect you in the event of a disability that renders you unable to 18 handle your affairs. Doing so now will ensure that your 19
