AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions relating to
- offenses involving danger to the person, further providing
- 4 for definitions.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The definition of "serious provocation" in
- 8 section 2301 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 9 Statutes is amended to read:
- 10 § 2301. Definitions.
- 11 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 12 provisions of this article which are applicable to specific
- 13 chapters or other provisions of this article, the following
- 14 words and phrases, when used in this article shall have, unless
- 15 the context clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to
- 16 them in this section:
- 17 * * *
- 18 "Serious provocation." Conduct sufficient to excite an

- 1 intense passion in a reasonable person. The term does not
- 2 <u>include the discovery</u>, knowledge or potential disclosure of a
- 3 <u>victim's actual or perceived gender identity or expression or</u>
- 4 <u>sexual orientation</u>, including circumstances in which the victim
- 5 <u>made an unwanted nonforcible romantic or sexual advance toward</u>
- 6 the defendant or if the defendant and victim had a romantic or
- 7 <u>sexual relationship.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
