## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for definitions and for
- regulatory authority of the board; and prohibiting Internet
- 4 gaming.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1103 of Title 4 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding definitions to read:
- 9 § 1103. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this part shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 \* \* \*
- 14 "Internet game." A variation or composite of any game that
- 15 <u>is offered through the Internet. The term shall include a</u>
- 16 contest or tournament conducted via the Internet in which
- 17 registered players compete against one another in one or more of
- 18 the Internet games or in a variation or composite of one or more
- 19 of the Internet games at any location.

- 1 "Internet gaming." The placing of a bet or wager on an
- 2 Internet game in this Commonwealth using a computer network of
- 3 both Federal and non-Federal interoperable packet switched data
- 4 <u>networks</u>.

- 6 Section 2. Section 1202 of Title 4 is amended by adding a
- 7 subsection to read:
- 8 § 1202. General and specific powers.

- 10 (c) Prohibited powers. -- The board shall be prohibited from
- 11 having any authority to promulgate regulations, issue licenses
- 12 or certificates or to implement programs that allow for the
- 13 <u>establishment of Internet gaming in this Commonwealth by any</u>
- 14 <u>licensed entity at any location in this Commonwealth.</u>
- 15 Section 3. Section 1518(a) of Title 4 is amended by adding a
- 16 paragraph to read:
- 17 § 1518. Prohibited acts; penalties.
- 18 (a) Criminal offenses.--

- 20 (9.2) It shall be unlawful for a person or a licensed
- 21 entity to possess, offer to the public, operate or permit
- 22 <u>another person or licensed entity to operate Internet gaming</u>
- in this Commonwealth.

- 25 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
