A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the month of April 2014 as "Distracted Driving Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Distracted driving is any activity that could divert
4	a person's attention from the primary task of driving; and
5	WHEREAS, All distractions endanger driver, passenger and
6	bystander safety; and
7	WHEREAS, Distracted driving occurs any time drivers take
8	their eyes off the road, their hands off the wheel and their
9	minds off their primary task of driving; and
10	WHEREAS, Studies show that texting involves manual, visual
11	and mental distraction and is among the worst of all driver
12	distractions; and
13	WHEREAS, Distracted driving is not confined to a single
14	cause, age group, level of education or driver demographic; and
15	WHEREAS, While distracted driving can take on many forms and
16	affects all road users, young drivers are at particular risk;

2 WHEREAS, Drivers less than 25 years of age are two to three 3 times more likely than older drivers to send text messages or e-4 mails while driving; and

5 WHEREAS, Motor vehicle accidents resulting from distracted 6 driving caused 421,000 people to be injured in 2012, a 9% 7 increase from 2011; and

8 WHEREAS, According to national statistics, in 2012, 3,328 9 people were killed in crashes involving a distracted driver; and 10 WHEREAS, The best way to end distracted driving is to educate 11 all Pennsylvanians about the danger it poses; therefore be it 12 RESOLVED, That the Senate urge drivers to consider the lives 13 of others on the road and avoid distracted driving; and be it 14 further

15 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of April 2014
16 as "Distracted Driving Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
