A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing April 8, 2014, as "Architects' Day" in Pennsylvania.

2 WHEREAS, It is important to recognize Architects' Day to  
3 remind the citizens of this Commonwealth of the unique  
4 contributions architects have made to the history, texture and  
5 quality of life in Pennsylvania; and

6 WHEREAS, The American Institute of Architects Pennsylvania  
7 (AIA PA), founded in 1909, is the Statewide component of the  
8 American Institute of Architects (AIA); and

9 WHEREAS, The AIA PA has a Statewide membership of more than  
10 2,700; and

11 WHEREAS, The beginning of an organized architectural  
12 profession in this nation was signified by the founding of the  
13 AIA 150 years ago; and

14 WHEREAS, Architects express the richness of our heritage and  
15 the vitality of spirit through the vigilant stewardship of great  
16 architectural and historical treasures; and

1       WHEREAS, Architects improve the quality of life for all  
2 individuals in this Commonwealth by combining advances in  
3 building technology with design innovation to build healthy,  
4 safe, livable and sustainable buildings and communities; and

5       WHEREAS, The AIA PA and its members advocate good community  
6 design and responsible stewardship of the built environment; and

7       WHEREAS, The AIA PA and its members maintain the highest  
8 standards of professional qualifications, ethics and  
9 advancements in training and education; therefore be it

10       RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize April 8, 2014, as  
11 "Architects' Day" in Pennsylvania.
