A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of October 2016 as "Italian-American 2 Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Explorer Christopher Columbus, the son of a wool
- 4 merchant, was born in Genoa, Italy, around 1451; and
- 5 WHEREAS, He was determined to find a quicker route west from
- 6 Europe to Asia and embarked on what would become four trips
- 7 across the Atlantic Ocean starting in 1492; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Christopher Columbus accidentally stumbled upon the
- 9 Americas during his voyage and his journeys resulted in
- 10 centuries of exploration on the American continent; and
- 11 WHEREAS, While Italians have always been a part of American
- 12 history, it was not until the 1820s that Italian immigrants
- 13 began moving to the United States in sizable numbers; and
- 14 WHEREAS, As Italian Americans began settling in major cities
- 15 across the United States, they often faced religious and ethnic
- 16 discrimination which occasionally led to brutal violence; and
- 17 WHEREAS, For this reason, Italian Americans started

- 1 celebrating the life and accomplishments of Christopher Columbus
- 2 as a way for citizens of Italian descent to be accepted by the
- 3 mainstream; and
- 4 WHEREAS, In 1937, President Franklin D. Roosevelt proclaimed
- 5 Columbus Day as a national holiday; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Today we credit Christopher Columbus with Italian
- 7 immigration to the New World and what is now Pennsylvania; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Currently, there are more than 17 million Americans
- 9 of Italian heritage in the United States, and more than 1.4
- 10 million Americans of Italian heritage reside in Pennsylvania;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, Allegheny County has the highest Italian-American
- 13 population in this Commonwealth, and is in the top 10 in the
- 14 country, with more than 194,000 people according to the 2000
- 15 United States Census; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Italian Americans have become one of this
- 17 Commonwealth's most influential ethnic groups, working
- 18 tirelessly to preserve their heritage; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Italian Americans have deep roots in religion,
- 20 politics, the arts, science, law and economic and social
- 21 institutions; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Today, the Order Sons of Italy in America is the
- 23 largest and oldest national organization for men and women of
- 24 Italian heritage in the United States, with many chapters
- 25 located in this Commonwealth; and
- 26 WHEREAS, This year, a new national historical library opened
- 27 up in downtown Pittsburgh where visitors can look at shelves
- 28 filled with more than 200 books and DVDs about Italian
- 29 Americans; therefore be it
- 30 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of October 2016

- 1 as "Italian-American Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania and commend
- 2 the early immigrants for their important role in our
- 3 Commonwealth's history.
