INTRODUCED AND ADOPTED, SEPTEMBER 15, 2014

A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of September 2014 as "Pulmonary Fibrosis
2 Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Pulmonary fibrosis is a lung disorder characterized
4 by a progressive scarring known as fibrosis and deterioration of
5 the lungs which slowly robs its patients of their ability to
6 breathe; and

7 WHEREAS, Pulmonary fibrosis, which affects at least 200,000
8 Americans with an estimated 48,000 new cases diagnosed each
9 year, has no Food and Drug Administration treatment or cure; and

10 WHEREAS, Pulmonary fibrosis affects children and adults and
11 studies have revealed there is a genetic component to this
12 disease in 15% of the cases; and

13 WHEREAS, Pulmonary fibrosis is difficult to diagnose and an
14 estimated two-thirds of patients die within five years of
15 diagnosis; and

16 WHEREAS, A patient's only means of survival is a lung

1 transplant; and

2 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania was the first and only state to develop
3 an initiative to proactively find and help patients afflicted by
4 this disease; and

5 WHEREAS, Five hospitals, Penn State Hershey Medical Center,
6 Temple University Hospital, the Hospital of the University of
7 Pennsylvania, University of Pittsburgh Medical Center and
8 Geisinger Medical Center, work together for the benefit of
9 patients; and

10 WHEREAS, In the month of September, the Coalition for
11 Pulmonary Fibrosis, a section 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization
12 founded in 2001, seeks to educate and advocate for patients and
13 their families and build national awareness and fundraising in
14 the race to find treatments and a cure for pulmonary fibrosis;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, Every mention of the disease is a step closer to
17 someone getting a timely and accurate diagnosis, receiving
18 essential support and ultimately finding a cure; therefore be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of September
20 2014 as "Pulmonary Fibrosis Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
