## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of October 25 through November 1, 2014, as Pennsylvania Education for Youth Experiencing Homelessness
- 3 Awareness Week."
- WHEREAS, In the 2012-2013 school year, 22,618 students in
- 5 Pennsylvania schools were homeless or without adequate housing;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, The purpose of this resolution is to educate the
- 8 public about the prevalence of youth experiencing homelessness,
- 9 the barriers that may prevent youth from attending school and
- 10 the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act that all schools must
- 11 comply with to overcome those barriers; and
- 12 WHEREAS, There are limited resources available to youth
- 13 experiencing homelessness, including the shortage of affordable
- 14 housing for displaced minors; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Homeless assistance service providers, as well as
- 16 community service opportunities for students and school service
- 17 organizations need public support; and

- 1 WHEREAS, There are many organizations committed to sheltering
- 2 and providing supportive services, meals and food supplies to
- 3 people experiencing homelessness; and
- 4 WHEREAS, There is still a dire need for additional resources
- 5 to assist students experiencing homelessness to attend school
- 6 and be successful, including the basic needs of food, clothing
- 7 and education supplies; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The purpose of Pennsylvania Education for Youth
- 9 Experiencing Homelessness Awareness Week is to encourage
- 10 schools, communities and individuals to plan for and support
- 11 assistance programs for youth experiencing homelessness as they
- 12 look to complete their education; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of October 25
- 14 through November 1, 2014, as "Pennsylvania Education for Youth
- 15 Experiencing Homelessness Awareness Week"; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That the Senate urge all citizens to recognize that
- 17 homelessness continues to be a serious problem for many youth
- 18 and families in this Commonwealth and encourage individuals and
- 19 organizations to support the many youth who are homeless.
