10	WHEREAS, Biomedical research has contributed to the
11	elimination of many epidemic diseases and in the United States
12	biomedical research has helped to prevent numerous childhood
13	killers; and
14	WHEREAS, Biomedical researchers are working diligently toward
15	cures for diseases such as Alzheimer's disease, arthritis, AIDS,
16	cancer, diabetes, epilepsy, heart and lung diseases, mental
17	illnesses, multiple sclerosis and countless other diseases that
