- 5 everyday life and 2014 marks the 27th anniversary of National
- 6 Chemistry Week; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The American Chemical Society coordinates National
- 8 Chemistry Week each year and it is designed to be a community-
- 9 based program that unites the local sections of the society with
- 10 schools, businesses and individuals; and
- 11 WHEREAS, More than 96% of all manufactured goods are directly
- 12 touched by chemistry, making chemistry an essential part of
- 13 every facet of this nation's economy; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The business of chemistry is a significant
- 15 contributor to the economy of this Commonwealth, employing
- 16 nearly 47,000 people; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Chemistry is intimately involved in the processing
