It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 22-7.4 of the General Laws entitled "Permanent Joint Committee
- 2 on Naming All New Buildings, Bridges, Edifices and Other State Constructions" is hereby

3 amended by adding thereto the following section:

- 4 <u>22-7.4-112. Leslie Cameron Greenhouse.</u> <u>The greenhouse building located at Rhode</u>
- 5 Island College, 600 Mt. Pleasant Avenue, Providence, Rhode Island, shall hereafter be named and
- 6 known as the "Leslie Cameron Greenhouse" in honor of Leslie Cameron, Rhode Island College
- 7 Class of 1970, who provided funding for the renovation of this facility.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
