RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES -- PUPIL TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 31-22.1-2 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-22.1 entitled "Pupil
Transportation Vehicles" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 31-22.1-2. Pupil transportation vehicle -- Vehicle standards. - (a) Vans, sport utility vehicles, and heavy automobiles as defined by applicable federal regulations may be used as 4 5 pupil transportation vehicles provided that these vehicles meet the highest federal 6 crashworthiness standards for these categories of vehicles. Unless otherwise specifically provided 7 for herein, the provisions of section 31-20-4, et seq. (Special Stops Required) shall be applicable 8 to pupil transportation vehicles. The provisions of section 31-23-42 (First aid kit and heating 9 equipment), section 31-23-42.2 (Power equipment on school buses), section 31-23-54 (Fire 10 extinguishers), section 31-23-55 (Speedometer and odometer) and section 31-23-56 (Stop arm) 11 shall be applicable to pupil transportation vehicles. A pupil transportation vehicle shall not be 12 required to be painted school bus yellow provided it carries a sign in school bus yellow visible 13 from forward and from in back of the vehicle containing the lettering required by section 31-20-14 11.

(b) Notwithstanding any other law or regulation, the school committee of any city, town
or regional school district is hereby authorized to sell advertising space on the exterior of school
buses, provided that no such advertising shall obstruct the vision of motorists or be inconsistent
with the safety regulations pertaining to school buses in Rhode Island general laws chapter 31-23.

- 1 Said school committees are hereby authorized to negotiate with private school bus carriers
- 2 regarding the content of said advertising, and the sharing of revenues derived therefrom.
- 3 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES -- PUPIL TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES

1 This act would authorize the school committee of any city, town or regional school 2 district to sell advertising space on school buses, and to negotiate with private school bus carriers 3 regarding the content of said advertising, and the sharing of revenues derived therefrom.

4 This act would take effect upon passage.
