It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5-20.8-5 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-20.8 entitled "Real Estate

2 Sales Disclosures" is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-20.8-5. Real estate disclosure form acknowledgement — Inclusion in real estate

4 <u>sales agreements — Penalty for violation.</u>

5 (a) Every agreement for the purchase and sale of residential real estate located in the state

6 shall contain an acknowledgement that a completed real estate disclosure form has been provided

- 7 to the buyer by the seller.
- 8 (b) Failure <u>A seller's failure</u> to provide the seller disclosure form to the buyer does not void
- 9 the agreement nor create any defect in title shall entitle the buyer to void the purchase and sales
- 10 agreement by providing notice, in writing, to the seller prior to the transfer of the title at a closing.
- 11 (c) Each violation of this statute by the seller or his or her agent is subject to a maximum
- 12 civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per occurrence.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 This act would allow a homebuyer to void a purchase and sales agreement prior to the

2 transfer if the seller fails to provide a written sales disclosure.

3 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
