It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 31-3-48.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-3 entitled 2 "Registration of Vehicles" is hereby amended to read as follows:

31-3-48.1. Plates for recipients of Distinguished Service Cross Plates for recipients of 3 Congressional Medal of Honor, Distinguished Service Cross, Navy Cross, Air Force Cross

- (a) The administrator of motor vehicles is empowered to make available to recipients of the Congressional Medal of Honor, United States Army Distinguished Service Cross, Navy Cross, Air Force Cross and Silver Star medals medal a special motor vehicle registration plate indicating the owner as a recipient of the distinguished service cross that medal. The applicant shall be required to pay a registration fee and a transfer charge of five dollars (\$5.00) for the plate.
- 12 (b) The plate shall contain the words "Distinguished Service Cross" name of the 13 appropriate medal across the top of the plate, shall bear an the insignia for the distinguished 14 service cross appropriate medal, and then a numeral or numerals.
  - (c) Upon the death of the holder of any "Distinguished Service Cross" such plate, the plate shall be transferred to the surviving spouse for the spouse's lifetime or until remarriage.
