### **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 754**

#### **HOUSE BILL NO. 2266**

## By Senator Reeves

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 29 and Title 66, relative to service and support animals.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 66-28-406(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (4) and substituting:

- (4) "Reliable documentation":
  - (A) Means written documentation provided by:
  - (i) A healthcare provider with actual knowledge of an individual's disability;
  - (ii) An individual or entity with a valid, unrestricted license, certification, or registration to serve persons with disabilities with actual knowledge of an individual's disability; or
  - (iii) A caregiver, reliable third party, or a governmental entity with actual knowledge of an individual's disability; and
- (B) Does not include documentation provided through a website, the primary function of which is to provide a certificate, registration, license, or similar document for a service animal or support animal for a fee;
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 66-7-111(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (4) and substituting:
  - (4) "Reliable documentation":
    - (A) Means written documentation provided by:
    - (i) A healthcare provider with actual knowledge of an individual's disability;
    - (ii) An individual or entity with a valid, unrestricted license, certification, or registration to serve persons with disabilities with actual knowledge of an individual's disability; or
    - (iii) A caregiver, reliable third party, or a governmental entity with actual knowledge of an individual's disability; and
  - (B) Does not include documentation provided through a website, the primary function of which is to provide a certificate, registration, license, or similar document for a service animal or support animal for a fee;

SECTION 3. This act takes effect July 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.
