## **SENATE BILL 623**

## AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39 and Title 40, relative to probation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-35-303, is amended by deleting subsection (a) and substituting:

A defendant is eligible for probation under this chapter if the sentence actually imposed upon the defendant is ten (10) years or less; however, no defendant is eligible for probation under this chapter if convicted of a violation of § 39-13-102(a)(1)(A)(i) or (ii); § 39-13-102(a)(1)(A)(iii) if the offense involved the actual discharge of a firearm; § 39-13-213(a)(2); § 39-13-304; § 39-13-402; § 39-13-504; § 39-13-532; § 39-15-402; § 39-17-417(b) or (i); § 39-17-1003; § 39-17-1004; or § 39-17-1005. A defendant shall also be eligible for probation pursuant to § 40-36-106(e)(3).

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2023, the public welfare requiring it, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
