SENATE BILL 2886

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 36, Chapter 3, Part 6; Title 38 and Title 40, relative to orders of protection.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 38, Chapter 8, Part 1, is amended by adding the following new section:

- (a) If a law enforcement officer becomes aware that an order of protection has been entered, pursuant to title 36, chapter 3, part 6, against a person in the officer's presence but the person has not been served with the order of protection, then the officer must take appropriate steps to facilitate service of the order of protection, including notifying the sheriff's department of the person's immediate location and any other information that may assist in service of the order of protection.
- (b) The curriculum requirements of the Tennessee peace officer standards and training commission established by this part must include instruction on the requirements of this section.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
