Mr. GRAVES of Georgia (for himself, Mr. WESTMORELAND, Mr. DUNCAN of South Carolina, and Mr. COLLINS of Georgia) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, Education and the Workforce, the Judiciary, Natural Resources, and House Administration, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To deauthorize appropriation of funds, and to rescind unobligated appropriations, to carry out the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defund Obamacare
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEAUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS TO**
2 **CARRY OUT PPACA AND HCERA.**

3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no funds
4 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out the provi-
5 sions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act
6 (Public Law 111–148), the Health Care and Education
7 Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–152), and
8 any amendment made by either such Act.

9 **SEC. 3. RESCISSION OF UNOBLIGATED APPROPRIATIONS**
10 **UNDER PPACA AND HCERA.**

11 Of the funds made available under any provision of
12 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public
13 Law 111–148), the Health Care and Education Reconcili-
14 ation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–152), and any amend-
15 ment made by either such Act, the unobligated balance
16 is rescinded.

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
