# <sup>111TH CONGRESS</sup> 2D SESSION H.R. 1995

## **AN ACT**

- To direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to prepare a report on the research and other public health activities of the Department of Health and Human Services with respect to diabetes among minority populations.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Diabetes in Minority3 Populations Evaluation Act of 2010".

4 SEC. 2. REPORT ON RESEARCH AND OTHER PUBLIC
5 HEALTH ACTIVITIES OF HHS WITH RESPECT
6 TO DIABETES AMONG MINORITY POPU7 LATIONS.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 18 months after 9 the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health 10 and Human Services shall submit to the Congress a report 11 on the research and other public health activities of the 12 Department of Health and Human Services with respect 13 to diabetes among minority populations.

(b) REQUIRED CONTENTS.—At a minimum, the report under subsection (a) shall include, with respect to research and activities described in subsection (a), the following:

18 (1) EVALUATION.—An evaluation of the fol-19 lowing:

20 (A) Research on diabetes among minority
21 populations, including with respect to—

(i) genetic, behavioral, and environmental factors that may contribute to disproportionate rates of diabetes among
these populations; and

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1	(ii) prevention of complications among
2	individuals within these populations who
3	have already developed diabetes.
4	(B) Surveillance and data collection on dia-
5	betes among minority populations, including
6	with respect to—
7	(i) efforts to better determine the
8	prevalence of diabetes among Asian Ameri-
9	cans and Pacific Islanders subgroups; and
10	(ii) efforts to coordinate data collec-
11	tion on the American Indian population.
12	(C) Community-based interventions tar-
13	geting minority populations, including with re-
14	spect to—
15	(i) the evidence base for such inter-
16	ventions;
17	(ii) the cultural appropriateness of
18	such interventions; and
19	(iii) efforts to educate the public on
20	the causes and consequences of diabetes.
21	(D) Education and training of health pro-
22	fessionals (including community health workers)
23	on the prevention and management of diabetes
24	and its related complications that is supported

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by the Health Resources and Services Adminis-
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tration, including through—
(i) the National Health Service Corps
program; and
(ii) the community health center pro-
gram.
(2) RECOMMENDATIONS.—Recommendations
for improvement of the research and other public
health activities of the Department of Health and
Human Services with respect to diabetes among mi-
nority populations, including recommendations for
coordination and comprehensive planning of such re-
search and activities.
(c) DEFINITION.—In this Act, the term "minority
population" means a racial and ethnic minority group, as
defined in section 1707(g) of the Public Health Service
Act (42 U.S.C. 300u-6(g)).
