A BILL

To amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to prohibit a government subsidy for the purchase of a health plan by a Member of Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Obamacare Sub-
5 sidies for Members of Congress Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. NO HEALTH CARE SUBSIDIES FOR MEMBERS OF**
2 **CONGRESS.**

3 Section 1312(d)(3)(D) of the Patient Protection and
4 Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18032(d)(3)(D)) is
5 amended—

6 (1) by redesignating clause (ii) as clause (iii);

7 and

8 (2) by inserting after clause (i) the following
9 new clause:

10 “(ii) NO PREMIUM ASSISTANCE FOR
11 MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.—Notwith-
12 standing any other provision of law or any
13 regulation or guidance promulgated by the
14 Director of the Office of Personnel Man-
15 agement, no Federal funds shall be ex-
16 pended to pay any portion of the premium
17 for a health plan purchased by a Member
18 of Congress pursuant to clause (i).”.

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
