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## A BILL

To amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to prohibit Government contributions under the Federal employees health benefit program towards Exchange health insurance coverage of Members of Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Special Treatment  
5 for Members of Congress Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NO GOVERNMENT CONTRIBUTIONS UNDER FEHB**  
2 **TOWARDS EXCHANGE HEALTH INSURANCE**  
3 **COVERAGE OF MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 1312(d)(3)(D) of the Pa-  
5 tient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C.  
6 18032(d)(3)(D)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
7 lowing new clause:

8 “(iii) **NO GOVERNMENT CONTRIBU-**  
9 **TION UNDER FEHB.**—No Government con-  
10 tribution under section 8906 of title 5,  
11 United States Code, shall be provided on  
12 behalf of an individual who is a Member of  
13 Congress for coverage made available to  
14 such individual pursuant to this subpara-  
15 graph.”.

16 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
17 subsection (a) shall apply as if included in the enactment  
18 of section 1312(d)(3)(D) of the Patient Protection and Af-  
19 fordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18032(d)(3)(D)).

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
