## A BILL

To amend the FAST Act to modify eligibility requirements for participation in a commercial driver pilot program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Waiving Hindrances  
5 to Economic Enterprise and Labor Act” or the “WHEEL  
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. COMMERCIAL DRIVER PILOT PROGRAM.**

2 Section 5404(f)(4) of the FAST Act (Public Law  
3 114–94; 49 U.S.C. 31315 note) is amended to read as  
4 follows:

5 “(4) COVERED DRIVER.—The term ‘covered  
6 driver’ means an individual who—

7 “(A) is between the ages of 18 and 21;

8 “(B) holds a valid commercial driver’s li-  
9 cense;

10 “(C) has a driving record without citations,  
11 violations, or other safety infractions; and

12 “(D) has received a certification of comple-  
13 tion of a training program or similar qualifica-  
14 tion, as determined appropriate by the Sec-  
15 retary, demonstrating skill and aptitude with  
16 respect to the operation of a commercial motor  
17 vehicle.”.
