A BILL

To amend title 46, United States Code, to reauthorize and amend the Fishing Safety Training Grant Program and the Fishing Safety Research Grant Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fishing Safety Train-
5 ing and Research Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION AND AMENDMENT OF FISHING**
2 **SAFETY TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM AND**
3 **FISHING SAFETY RESEARCH GRANT PRO-**
4 **GRAM.**

5 (a) FISHING SAFETY TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM.—

6 Section 4502(i) of title 46, United States Code, is amend-
7 ed—

8 (1) by redesignating paragraph (4) as para-
9 graph (6);

10 (2) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
11 lowing:

12 “(4)(A) The Secretary shall establish a publicly ac-
13 cessible electronic database that lists the names of individ-
14 uals who have participated in training sessions carried out
15 with assistance under this subsection.

16 “(B) The Secretary shall require, as a condition of
17 including the name of an individual in such database for
18 any period longer than 18 months, that the individual
19 complete retraining.

20 “(5) The Secretary shall require that training carried
21 out with a grant under this section shall be made available
22 in languages other than English, as appropriate for the
23 fishing port in which the training is offered.”; and

24 (3) in paragraph (6), as so redesignated, by
25 striking “2010 through 2014” and inserting “2015
26 through 2025”.

1 (b) FISHING SAFETY RESEARCH GRANT PRO-
2 GRAM.—Section 4502(j)(4) of title 46, United States
3 Code, is amended by striking “2010 through 2014” and
4 inserting “2015 through 2025”.
