3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Safe Housing for5 Homeless Veterans Act".

12 "(a) LIMITATION.—The Secretary may not make a 13 grant or provide other assistance to any entity for the provision of housing or services to homeless veterans under 14 this chapter unless the entity submits to the Secretary a 15 certification that the building where the entity proposes 16 to provide such housing or services is in compliance with 17 codes relevant to operations and level of care provided, in-18 19 cluding the most current Life Safety Code and all applica-20 ble State and local housing codes, licensing requirements, 21 fire and safety requirements, and any other requirements 22 in the jurisdiction in which the project is located regarding 23 the condition of the structure and the operation of the 24 supportive housing or service center.

"(b) PRIORITY IN ADMINISTRATION OF GRANTS.—In 25 awarding grants and providing other assistance under this 26 •HR 4079 IH

chapter, the Secretary shall give priority to an entity seek ing a grant or assistance for a project that includes mak ing improvements to a building where the entity proposes
to provide housing or services to homeless veterans to en sure that such building meets codes relevant to operations
and level of care provided, as required under subsection
(a).".

8 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-9 tions at the beginning of such chapter is amended 10 by adding at the end of the items relating to such 11 subchapter the following new item:

"2004. Condition on the award of grants and other assistance for the provision of housing or services to homeless veterans.".

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by 13 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to an application 14 for a grant or other assistance under chapter 20 of title 15 38, United States Code, submitted on or after the date 16 of the enactment of this Act.

17 (c) TREATMENT OF CURRENT RECIPIENTS.—In the 18 case of the recipient of a grant or other assistance under 19 chapter 20 of title 38, United States Code, that receives 20 grant funds or other assistance provided by the Secretary 21 of Veterans Affairs for the fiscal year during which this 22 Act is enacted, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall re-23 quire the recipient to submit the certification required 24 under section 2004 of such title, as added by subsection (a), by not later than two years after the date of the enact ment of this Act. If the recipient fails to submit such cer tification by such date, the Secretary may not make any
additional payments or provide other assistance to the re cipient under such chapter until the recipient submits such
certification.
