A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Welfare for Weed
5 Act of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO FOOD AND NUTRITION ACT OF**
7 **2008.**

8 Section 3(k) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008
9 (7 U.S.C. 2012(k)) is amended by inserting “, marijuana
10 products,” after “tobacco,”.

11 **SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON USE OF ELECTRONIC BENEFIT**
12 **TRANSFER CARD TO ACCESS TANF ASSIST-**
13 **ANCE AT ANY STORE THAT OFFERS MARI-**
14 **JUANA FOR SALE.**

15 Section 408(a)(12)(A) of the Social Security Act (42
16 U.S.C. 608(a)(12)(A)) is amended—

17 (1) by striking “or” at the end of clause (ii);

18 (2) by striking the period at the end of clause

19 (iii) and inserting “; or”; and

20 (3) by adding at the end the following:

21 “(iv) any establishment that offers
22 marihuana (as defined in section 102(16)
23 of the Controlled Substances Act) for
24 sale.”.

1 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
3 take effect 1 year after the date of the enactment of this
4 Act.
