A BILL

To streamline the budget process at the Department of Defense, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Streamline Pentagon
5 Budgeting Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REPORTING REQUIREMENTS RELATED**
7 **TO UNFUNDED PRIORITIES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 9 of title 10, United
9 States Code, is amended—

10 (1) by repealing section 222a;

1 (2) by repealing section 222b; and

2 (3) in the table of sections at the beginning of
3 the chapter, by striking the items relating to sec-
4 tions 222a and 222b.

5 (b) **MILITARY CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.**—Section
6 2806 of the Military Construction Authorization Act for
7 Fiscal Year 2018 (division B of Public Law 115–91; 10
8 U.S.C. 222a note) is hereby repealed.

9 (c) **NATIONAL NUCLEAR SECURITY ADMINISTRA-**
10 **TION.**—

11 (1) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 4716 of the Atomic
12 Energy Defense Act (50 U.S.C. 2756) is hereby re-
13 pealed.

14 (2) **CLERICAL AMENDMENT.**—The table of con-
15 tents at the beginning of the Atomic Energy Defense
16 Act is amended by striking the item relating to sec-
17 tion 4716.
