Mr. HUFFMAN (for himself, Mr. HOLT, and Mr. ELLISON) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To prohibit the Export-Import Bank of the United States from providing financial support for certain high carbon intensity energy projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON EXPORT-IMPORT BANK SUP-**
4 **PORT FOR CERTAIN HIGH CARBON INTEN-**
5 **SITY ENERGY PROJECTS.**

6 Section 2(b) of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945
7 (12 U.S.C. 635(b)) is amended by adding at the end the
8 following:

9 “(14) PROHIBITION ON SUPPORT FOR CERTAIN
10 HIGH CARBON INTENSITY ENERGY PROJECTS.—

1 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Bank shall not guar-
2 antee, insure, extend credit, or participate in the ex-
3 tension of credit in connection with the purchase or
4 sale of any good or service for a high carbon inten-
5 sity project.

6 “(B) HIGH CARBON INTENSITY PROJECT DE-
7 FINED.—In subparagraph (A), the term ‘high car-
8 bon intensity project’ means a project that—

9 “(i) is designed to generate electricity; and
10 “(ii) if completed, would produce at least
11 500 grams of carbon dioxide per kilowatt-hour
12 of electricity generated by the project.”.

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
