## A BILL

To amend the Energy Policy and Conservation Act to direct the Secretary of Energy to submit to Congress a report containing an assessment of any physical or cybersecurity incidents to a storage facility or a related facility of the Strategic Petroleum Reserve.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may cited as the “Strategic Petroleum Re-  
5 serve Security Assessment Act” or the “SPR Security As-  
6 sessment Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ANNUAL INCIDENT ASSESSMENT.**

2 Section 161 of the Energy Policy and Conservation  
3 Act (42 U.S.C. 6241) is amended by adding at the end  
4 the following:

5 “(k) ANNUAL INCIDENT ASSESSMENT.—

6 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days  
7 after the date of enactment of this subsection, and  
8 every year thereafter, the Secretary shall submit to  
9 Congress a report containing an assessment of any  
10 physical or cybersecurity incidents to a storage facil-  
11 ity or a related facility of the Reserve.

12 “(2) REQUIREMENTS.—The assessment re-  
13 quired under paragraph (1) shall include the fol-  
14 lowing:

15 “(A) The dates of each physical or cyberse-  
16 curity incident that occurred.

17 “(B) The resolution of such physical or cy-  
18 bersecurity incident.

19 “(C) The local, State, and Federal agen-  
20 cies that assisted in mitigating such physical or  
21 cybersecurity incident.

22 “(D) Any other information the Secretary  
23 determines necessary.”.
