3 **SECTION 1. TOBACCO-RELATED AGRICULTURE EMPLOY-**
4 **MENT OF CHILDREN.**

5 Section 3(l) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938
6 (29 U.S.C. 203(l)) is amended by adding at the end the
7 following: “Any employment in which children under the
8 age of 18 come into direct contact with tobacco plants or
9 dried tobacco leaves shall be considered particularly haz-

1 arduous oppressive child labor within the meaning of this
2 subsection.”.
