## A BILL

To prohibit certain nutrition rules with respect to foods  
sold at schools as a fundraiser.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bringing Awareness  
5 and Knowledge to Exempt Schools Against Legislative  
6 Encroachment Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN RULES.**

8 The Secretary of Agriculture shall not implement, ad-  
9 minister, or enforce the rule entitled “National School  
10 Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program: Nutrition

1 Standards for All Foods Sold in School as Required by  
2 the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010” published  
3 by the Department of Agriculture in the Federal Register  
4 on June 28, 2013 (78 Fed. Reg. 39068 et seq.) with re-  
5 spect to food sold as a fundraiser that takes place on the  
6 grounds of a school.
