## A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to expand the definition of an unauthorized alien to include aliens who have not been admitted to and are not lawfully present in the United States, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Defense of Legal  
5       Workers Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADMISSION AND LAWFUL PRESENCE REQUIRED**  
2 **FOR EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION.**

3 Section 274A(h)(3) of the Immigration and Nation-  
4 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1324a(h)(3)) is amended—

5 (1) by inserting before “authorized to be so em-  
6 ployed by this Act” the following: “an alien other-  
7 wise admitted to and lawfully present in the United  
8 States, and”; and

9 (2) by inserting at the end the following: “An  
10 alien without lawful status shall be considered to be  
11 an unauthorized alien for purposes of this Act.”.
