A BILL

To exclude individuals who are not citizens of the United States from the number of persons used to determine the apportionment of Representatives and the number of electoral votes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Representation
5 Without Legal Immigration Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXCLUSION OF NONCITIZENS FROM NUMBER OF**
2 **PERSONS USED TO DETERMINE APPORTION-**
3 **MENT OF REPRESENTATIVES AND NUMBER**
4 **OF ELECTORAL VOTES.**

5 (a) **EXCLUSION.**—Section 22(a) of the Act entitled
6 “An Act to provide for the fifteenth and subsequent decen-
7 nial censuses and to provide for an apportionment of Rep-
8 resentatives in Congress”, approved June 18, 1929 (2
9 U.S.C. 2a(a)), is amended by striking “not taxed” and in-
10 serting “not taxed and individuals who are not citizens
11 of the United States”.

12 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
13 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to the appor-
14 tionment of Representatives carried out pursuant to the de-
15 cennial census conducted during 2030 and any succeeding
16 decennial census.
